



MEMORIAL GARDEN RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) The Memorial Garden is available for the cremated remains of members or former members of the church, their spouses, minor children who might apply and be approved by the Cemetery Committee. No ashes will be placed without a committal service or prayer by the pastor of Pendleton United Methodist Church or person approved by the pastor.
- 2) Upon the use of the Memorial Garden a brass plaque will be attached to the Memorial Garden wall with the name of the person placed and date of birth and date of death. The cost of this plaque will be paid by the estate of the person placed in the Memorial Garden. All of the plaques will be uniform in size and style.
- 3) Flowers, decorations or other similar adornments may not be placed on or near the Memorial Garden.
- 4) Pendleton United Methodist Church will endeavor to protect the ashes placed in the Memorial Garden but it assumes no responsibility with respect to such ashes other than to afford them such protection as it affords its own property. Such ashes are not covered by the church's insurance.
- 5) The Cemetery Committee is a continuing committee elected by the Charge Conference of Pendleton United Methodist Church whose terms are set by the Charge Conference.
- 6) The use of the Memorial Garden, and all terms, conditions, rules and regulations relating thereto, is subject to the determination and control of the Council of Stewards of Pendleton United Methodist Church. The Cemetery Committee reserves the right without notice to amend and/or repeal such terms, conditions, rules and regulations, and, whether now in effect or hereafter made or established, shall be binding upon each and every person. .
- 7) Pendleton United Methodist Church reserves the right to relocate the Memorial Garden to any other location within the property of the Church in the event future events require this move.
