The Congregational Life Committee is an active part of the church, serving meals for families during bereavement, illness and other times of need. They also organize events in the church that bring the church families together. If you would like to be part of a team, please let the church office know. New members are always needed. You'll find being part of this ministry to be very rewarding as a church member.

It is my pleasure to report to you that **Magi** provided Christmas gifts and groceries to 117 families with 335 children this year. Without your commitment and direct involvement it is highly likely many of the children would not have experienced the magic and true meaning of Christmas. Most of the parents and children expressed their sincere appreciation and gratitude for everyone involved with **Magi Christmas**. On their behalf, thank you.

From an operational standpoint, this year was our best. Consider that in addition to Christmas, 2019 was the second year of **Magi Summer**. Over the three months of summer we distributed groceries to 65 families with over 275 children. And finally, we successfully launched the third phase of Magi, Anderson County Alternative School. You will learn much more about the third phase during the coming year.

Sixteen churches in Anderson County School District 4 together with Mt. Lebanon PTO and Pendleton High School Beta Club make this, truly, a community effort. We had very few issues executing our programs this year. It is a true testament to the number excellent school administrators, generous donors and willing volunteers we have each year. Also, it is worth repeating, "We are blessed to live in a community with so many caring, loving people". God bless all of you.

We need your help! Every day, Family Promise of Anderson County is making a positive difference in someone's life. It has been said "give a man a fish and you feed him for a day; teach a man to fish and you feed him for a lifetime." At Family Promise of Anderson County, we do both with our guest families.

During the last eight years of this ministry, our shelter program has provided over 20,000 bed nights and served close to 44,000 meals. Our program starts with emergency shelter, which is an absolute essential, but shelter is only the start. All families who enter our program are assisted in the development of a plan for success leading toward self-sufficiency. If unemployed or under-employed they are provided both information and coaching on techniques required to obtain and maintain employment. They also receive budgeting and financial planning strategies for stretching every paycheck to make the most of it, while planning for the establishment of an emergency savings fund. Since January 2015, 100% of our transitional housing graduates and 80% of our non-transitional housing graduates remain in permanent housing. Simply put, our program works and positively changes lives. The next Family Promise Week at PUMC begins Sunday, January 19<sup>th</sup>.
